

All coaches hold 5 year renewable high school permits and all are certified in CPR/First Aid and concussion awareness. All coaches also coach very successful high school



cheerleading programs. The head coach of our varsity program, Joann Tatarzycki, was just awarded the CHSCA (Connecticut high school coaches association) coach of the year award.

The Danbury PAL Cheer program is the current - 3 years running - FCIAC league middle school champions!

We are the current and several years running NECA (New England cheerleading association) grand champions middle school division.
